Intimate activity
1. Fantasizing
2. Writing love letters

13. Sexual intercourse

Meaning
A. Giving or receiving a kiss on the cheek
B. Spending time together: for instance talking, or playing games or taking a walk
C. Kissing with the mouth and tongue, also called 'French kissing'.
D. Touching and caressing each other in a sexually arousing way.
E. Touching and stimulating each other's genitals (penis, vagina).
F. Stimulating the anus with finger, or penetrating with a finger or penis.
G. A sexual act where the erect penis enters the vagina. Both penis and vagina are stimulated.
H. Imagining being with another person or thinking about why you like them.
I. Arranging time together regularly to get to know each other.
J. Holding hands, to feel close and connected.
K. Playfully showing someone you're attracted to them in ways they can't ignore, like smiling, giving compliments and making the other person feel special.
L. Hugging or cuddling to show how much you care for each other.
M. Using the mouth to pleasure the penis or vagina, or both.
N. Sharing your feelings and other secrets in a letter to someone special to you.
